



The following environment policy statement was approved by the Board at its meeting held on 18th March 2015:

MannaCare believes that it has a responsibility to care for and protect the environment in which it operates. MannaCare is committed to minimising the impact of its activities on the environment and fostering the sustainable use of the Earth's resources.

MannaCare will:

1. Minimise waste and its environmental impact by evaluating operations and ensuring they are as energy efficient as possible;
2. Actively promote recycling both internally and by its clients and suppliers;
3. Give a preference to buying sustainable products^[1];
4. Use mains potable water responsibly and take advantage of opportunities to substitute water from other sources;
5. Meet or exceed all the environmental legislation that relates to MannaCare;
6. Raise staff awareness of good environmental practices and enlist their support in improving MannaCare's and their own environmental performance by integrating environmental training into the organisation's training program;
7. Publicise its environmental position;
8. Continually assess the environmental impact of all its operations to improve environmental performance.
